IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
Multiple Violations at ANNAPOLIS PWS – 2024 to 2026

Este informe contiene información muy importante sobre su agua potable.

The Annapolis PWS public water system (ID # MO4010017, Iron Co.) has had multiple violations of monitoring requirements and drinking water standards from **October 2024** through **February 2026**. During this time period this system two monitoring violations, and one reporting violation.

In **January 2026, and February 2026**, this public water system failed to submit enough valid routine samples for total coliform testing, resulting in a minor monitoring violation for the month.

During the months of monitoring violations, we cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water. Bacteriologically contaminated water can cause a variety of disease symptoms. It is important to routinely test drinking water to ensure the safety of those that consume it.

We were required to develop and submit to the State an initial service line inventory that includes all service lines connected to the public water distribution system and characterize the materials of those service lines as either lead, galvanized requiring replacement, non-lead, or lead status unknown. Our system failed to submit an initial inventory of service lines to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources by **October 16, 2024**. Public notice is required for all these violations. Performing public notice now resolves this issue. Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have direct access to this information. You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.

What happened? What is being done? Describe corrective action(s).

We have been advised by DNR how the paperwork needs to be filled out and will continue submitting correct paperwork and samples. The service line inventory has been completed and submitted.
